Use of the Sports Premium

At Windmill L.E.A.D. Academy, like all schools across the country, we receive funding under the brief 'Sports Premium'. This funding is allocated to promote the importance of Physical Education and healthy lifestyle choices. Here at Windmill, we want to provide the best possible physical education to our pupils as well as promoting sport as an enjoyable and valuable recreational activity. Therefore, facilitating after school and before school sporting chances, as well as opportunities for competitive sport, is vital.

During the academic year 2014/15 Windmill L.E.A.D. Academy received £5,673 and this was used for the following:

- To provide an outstanding PE teacher to deliver PE sessions to each class across school
- To provide a variety of after school clubs with a sporty feel
- To enable children to compete in sporting activities with other schools

We employ an outstanding specialist PE teacher, Mr Rose, 4 days per week.
