#### Playground Project

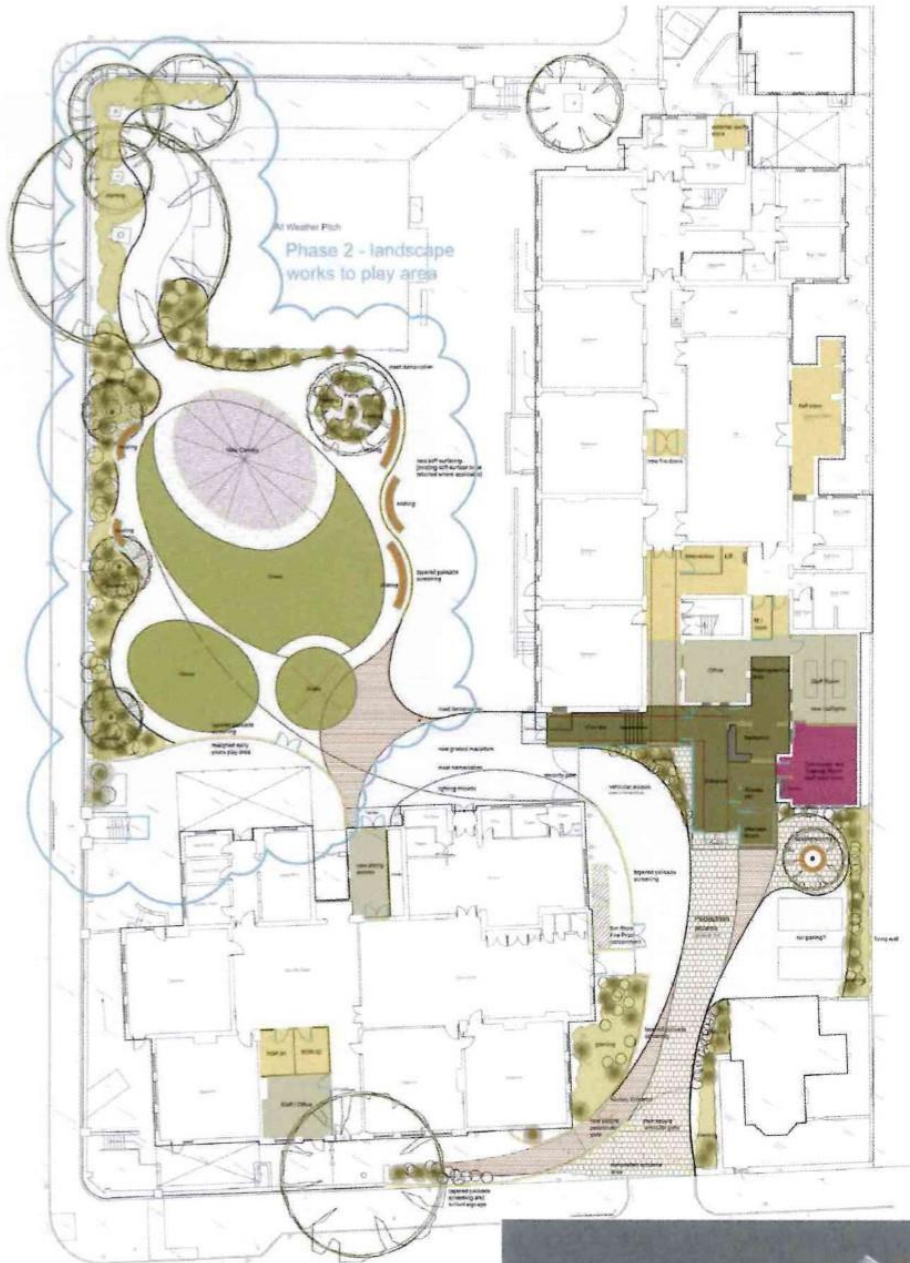
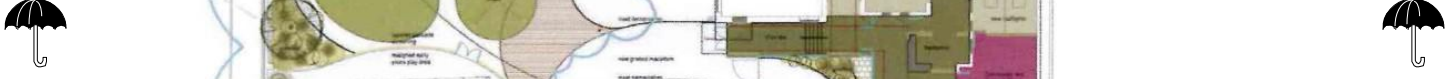
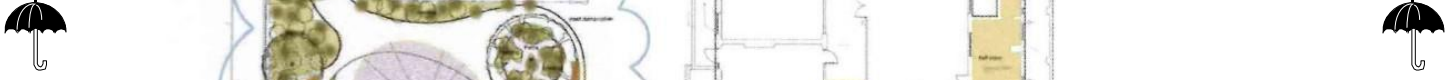
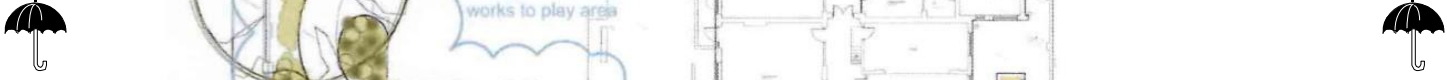
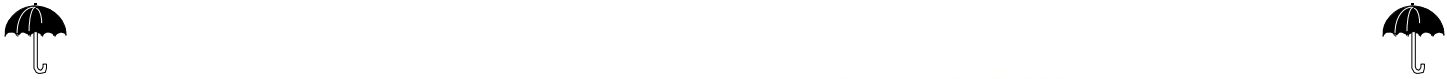
