



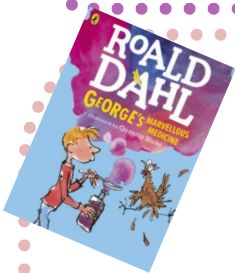
Year 4 Newsletter—Autumn 2 2020

Year 4 Curriculum

English

Our novel this term is called 'George's Marvellous Medicine', written by the famous children's author Roald Dahl. The story involves a boy called George who decides to mix up a foul potion and links to our topic for this term: Potions. In writing lessons, we will be writing to compare the characters in the story, creating our own wonderfully creative potion recipes and devising our own narratives.

Maths

This half term we will begin with learning written methods for harder addition and subtraction calculations. We will then move on to data handling and securing our multiplication and division facts. Children will learn how to quickly and mentally divide by 100. As always, secure times table knowledge is essential to quick and accurate calculations, so please encourage your child to use Times Table Rock Stars regularly.

Topic

Your child should have already brought home their knowledge organiser for this term. Please read through it with your child, scan the QR codes, help them with the vocabulary and look at the beautiful images provided. Our topic is 'Potions' and we will be learning about the history of medical advances, sketching potion bottles and learning about states of matter in



Other Information
