A) 2D Art (Drawing and Painting)	<p>ALL: I can use the terminology of line, shape, pattern, colour, texture, value, space, depth, perspective and composition correctly.</p> <p>ALL: I can use sketching techniques to show form and depth, including the texture of fabrics, glass, nature, brick, clay, hair, fur and skin.</p> <p>MOST: I can use marks and lines to produce increasingly realistic- looking texture</p> <p>ALL: I can draw increasingly accurate facial shapes and detailed facial features, which convey an intended expression or emotion.</p> <p>ALL: I can combine detailed facial features with careful colour choice to communicate emotions clearly, showing imagination, confidence and a sense of self through my artwork.</p> <p>MOST: I can take risks with my work and experiment with styles</p> <p>ALL: I can bring a range of sketching techniques to a piece of work, with increased accuracy, confidence and independence.</p> <p>ALL: I can make and explain colour choices, detailing how contrasting, complementary, warm or cool colours enhance my work and the justifications behind my choices.</p> <p>SOME: I can demonstrate a secure knowledge about warm and cool colours and explain why certain colours work better with certain pieces.</p> <p>ALL: I can confidently combine elements of art, through variety of medium, to create an aesthetically pleasing effect, showing an awareness of composition.</p> <p>ALL: I can show perspective in my work by drawing one or two point perspective, with a vanishing point.</p>
