Year 1	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Recall and discuss the Christian creation story.</li> <li>2) Recall the Christmas story.</li> <li>3) Recall and discuss a story about Jesus demonstrating friendship.</li> <li>4) Recall the Easter story and recognise some of the associated symbols.</li> <li>5) Use the right names for things that are special to Jewish people during Shabbat and explain why.</li> <li>6) Describe what Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur are about.</li> </ol>
Year 2	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Recall when Jesus showed kindness or shared the importance of being kind.</li> <li>2) Understand that Christians believe Jesus was a gift from God.</li> <li>3) Describe how Muslims pray and why they do this.</li> <li>4) Recall what Christians believe happened on Easter Sunday.</li> <li>5) Explain what happens when Muslims pray alone or at a mosque.</li> <li>6) Describe some of the events that happen during Hajj and explain why these are important to Muslims.</li> </ol>
Year 3	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Describe how Hindus celebrate Diwali.</li> <li>2) Explain why Christians believe God gave Jesus to the world.</li> <li>3) Explain Christian viewpoints about one of Jesus' healing miracles.</li> <li>4) Understand why Christians believe Jesus' death was important.</li> <li>5) Describe Hindu beliefs about gods and Brahman.</li> <li>6) Describe Hindu rituals at the River Ganges and significance of these to Hindus.</li> </ol>
Year 4	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Recall the Buddha's life story and what he did to try to be happy.</li> <li>2) Understand what Christmas symbols teach Christians about Jesus.</li> <li>3) Recall one of the Buddha's stories and its teachings.</li> <li>4) Describe what a Christian might learn about forgiveness from a Biblical text.</li> <li>5) Describe how aspects of the 8-fold path help Buddhists know how to live good lives.</li> <li>6) Describe some of the ways Christians use churches to worship.</li> </ol>
Year 5	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Make links between religious practice and underpinning beliefs in Sikhism.</li> <li>2) Explain the Christian belief that Jesus was the Incarnation of God.</li> <li>3) Explain the relevance of a Sikh story to a Sikh or non-Sikh person.</li> <li>4) Explain whether Jesus' crucifixion was God's intention or a consequence of events.</li> <li>5) Describe the different ways Sikhs show their commitment to God.</li> <li>6) Understand that Christians can show their commitment to God in different ways and will prioritise these differently.</li> </ol>
Year 6	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Describe different ways Muslims show their commitment to God.</li> <li>2) Describe how Christians celebrate Christmas and why.</li> <li>3) Make links between Christian beliefs and the concept of eternity.</li> </ol>
