



<b>Geography End of Year Expectations – Year 1 – All, Most and Some.</b>	
A) Geographical Skills and Fieldwork	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) ALL - I can use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of my school.</li><li>2) ALL - I can use simple locational and directional language (near and far; left and right). <b>MOST: I can use simple locational and directional language to describe a route.</b></li><li>3) ALL - I can use maps and atlases to identify the United Kingdom and its countries.</li><li>4) <b>ALL – I can draw a simple map of a real or imaginary place.</b> MOST - I can draw a simple map of a real or imaginary place, adding simple labels and markers.</li></ol>
B) Human and Physical Geography.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) ALL: I can complete a simple weather chart and answer questions about the weather in the United Kingdom.</li><li>2) ALL: I can make plausible predictions about what the weather may be like later in the day or tomorrow in the United Kingdom. <b>MOST: I can make plausible prediction about the weather, using my knowledge of the seasons.</b></li><li>3) ALL: I can explain how the weather changes with each season in the United Kingdom.</li></ol>
C) Locational Knowledge.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) ALL - I can name the 4 countries of the UK and the town where I live. <b>MOST – I can identify where I live on a map of the UK.</b></li></ol>
D) Place Knowledge.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) ALL - I can compare similarities and differences between my local area and an area in another country. <b>MOST – I can use maps and photographs to identify similarities and differences between my local area and an area in another country.</b></li></ol>
