A) Geographical Skills and Fieldwork	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) ALL - I can research features of cities and villages. MOST – I can identify features of cities and villages on a map. SOME – I can explain some of the reasons for these features.2) ALL - I can use digital maps to identify different locations MOST - I can use digital maps to identify different locations and describe their geographical features. SOME – I can use digital maps to identify and compare geographical features.3) ALL - I can use digital technologies to accurately measure the distance between two locations.4) ALL - I can use symbols and keys on maps to build my knowledge of the UK and the wider world. MOST – I can use symbols and keys on maps to compare different locations.5) ALL - I can observe and measure human and physical features in the local area using charts and graphs to record and present findings. MOST – I can observe and measure human and physical features in order to draw accurate conclusions about the local area
B) Human and Physical Geography	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) ALL - I can recognise and explain how people are trying to manage their environment to improve it and keep them safe. MOST – I can evaluate whether or not I think these management strategies are effective.2) ALL - I can explain why people are attracted to living in cities.3) ALL - I can explain why people may choose to live in a village rather than a city.4) ALL - I can report on ways in which humans have both improved and damaged the environment. MOST – I can consider the reasons behind these human actions. SOME – I can think of some possible solutions to environmental issues.
C) Locational Knowledge	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) ALL - I know the difference between the British Isles, Great Britain and UK. SOME – I can explain the difference between the British Isles, Great Britain and the UK using a map to help me.2) ALL - I can name up to six cities in the UK and locate them on a map.3) ALL - I can locate and name some of the main islands that surround the U.K.4) ALL - I can name several counties of Britain including those neighbouring where I live. MOST – I can explain the difference between a city and a county. SOME – I can explain the historical influence on some county names.
D) Place Knowledge	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) ALL - I am aware that different places may have both similar and different characteristics. MOST – I can describe the similar and different characteristics found in different places. SOME – I can explain why different places may have different characteristics, using evidence from maps to support my answer.1) ALL - I can explain how a locality has changed over time with reference to physical features. MOST – I can explain the reasons behind some of these changes, applying my historical knowledge to do this.
