A) Geographical Skills and Fieldwork	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) ALL - I can use OS maps to answer questions. MOST – I can use OS maps to answer questions, using evidence from the maps to justify my answers.2) ALL - I can recognise all key symbols used on ordnance survey maps.3) ALL - I can use maps, aerial photos, plans and web resources to describe what a locality might be like. MOST – I can use maps, aerial photos, plans and web resources to compare different localities.4) I can create a scale plan of the local area, using digital technologies to measure, observe and record distances and geographical features.
B) Human and Physical Geography	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) ALL - I can give an extended description of the human features of different places around the world.2) ALL - I can understand the term sustainable development. MOST – I can give examples of sustainable development. SOME – I can suggest ways to improve the use of sustainable resources in school and around the local area.3) ALL - I can name the mountain regions of North and South America.
C) Locational Knowledge	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) ALL - I can locate the USA and Canada on a world map and atlas.2) ALL - I can identify and name the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn as well as the Arctic and Antarctic circles. MOST – I can identify countries located along the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn.3) ALL - I can name the main lines of latitude and longitude. MOST – I can use the lines of latitude or longitude to locate a country.4) ALL - I can explain how the time zones work. MOST – I can identify the time zone of a given country. SOME – I can explain the effects of time zones on travellers.5) ALL - I can locate and name the main countries in South America on a world map and atlas.
